


# **USDA Summer Food Service Program: Insights from the COVID-19 Distribution Response**

#### **Host Organization**

- **Operation Food Search:** anti-hunger non profit in St. Louis and one of the leading providers of summer meals in Missouri
- Internship site placement facilitated through the **Zero Hunger Internship** of the Congressional Hunger Center

#### Intern Responsibilities

- Student intern (AA) served as site **supervisor** for SFSP at 6 sites
- Managed a team of 5 volunteers
- Facilitated outreach with over 50 external organizations and 6 school districts across St. Louis County

## Background

The USDA Summer Food Service **Program** (SFSP) is a federally-funded, state-administered program that reimburses programs providing free, nutritious meals to children under 18 when school is not in session.

- COVID-19 influenced an unprecedented use of the SFSP<sup>1</sup>
- Need to adapt distribution model to accommodate **public health** protocols<sup>1</sup>

### **Methods:** Policy Mechanisms


Drive-thru, contactless distribution model employed by Operation Food Search was strengthened by federal policy enacting **nationwide waivers**:

Allowing parents and guardians to pick up meals

Waiving meal time requirements

## **Results:** COVID-19 Distribution Model

The current SFSP distribution model (Fig. 1 and Table 1) depicts an overall *increase* in children's meals served from summer 2019 to summer 2021

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Allowing noncongregate feeding

Children's meal boxes were served in graband-go format and packed with a 7-day supply of breakfast and lunch.
