**Kimberly Montez, MD, MPH, FAAP** is an Associate Professor of Pediatrics and Social Sciences & Health Policy, Associate Program Director for the Pediatric Residency, Vice Chair for Justice, Equity, Diversity, Inclusion for the Pediatrics Department, and the Associate Director in Pediatrics at the Maya Angelou Center for Health Equity at the Wake Forest University School of Medicine.

Dr. Montez's research focuses on pediatric food insecurity, health equity, and community-engagement. She co-authored the Food Insecurity Toolkit for Pediatricians with the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) and the Food Research & Action Center (FRAC) and is a lead author for the upcoming revision of the AAP Food Security Policy Statement. In 2022, she received the AAP Minority Health Equity and Inclusion Award for Excellence in Health Equity.
